The latest heraldic Letter of Acceptances and Returns (LoAR) has been published. Congrats to the following!

Tonya Nelson - Name: Tegzes Kato (Submitted as Tegzes Kató, the underlying documentation for the given name shows it as Kato, without a diacritical marking. We have made this correction for registration. Questions were raised in commentary about the spelling of the byname Tegzes. After the close of commentary, Kólosvari Arpadne Julia documented the spelling Tegzes to the 15th and 16th centuries. Nice 16th century Hungarian name!)

Jackie / Soma - Device: Or, in bend three paw prints bendwise azure. (There is a step from period practice for the use of paw prints)

Jackie / Soma - Badge: Or, a paw print bendwise azure. (There is a step from period practice for the use of paw prints)

Troy / Helias - Name: Helias Hawke (Nice 16th century English name!)

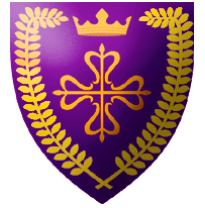

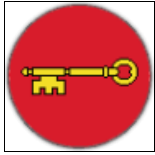

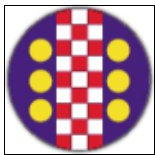
