

As a new member of the SCA, and to a stranger to long-term camping for a good number of years, Lilies War was a bit of a culture-shock. While "culture-shock" may sound like a negative term, that is far from the case. Lilies was one of the most wonderful experiences that I've had in recent memory. I'd say Lilies was my first event, but that distinction goes to Warrior Child, with its own stories and experiences. Lilies was my first serious camping event of any great duration. The best place to start in the recollection of any story would be the beginning. I had the privilege of staying in a canvas tent, and enjoying a meal plan of period pies. Having both of those made my time spent in camp pleasurable, as the food was delicious, and the tent was a cool respite from the heat of the day. When I wasn't cozied up in the tent, I spent a great deal of time taking in all that I could. One of the first things I did after arriving on site was make my way to Herald's Point. As one interested in Heraldry, this was a natural first stop. I managed to make it in time to help out if the afternoon Cries for the day (something I made a point to assist with when I was able to). When Cries were over, there were still consultations going on, which I helped out with as well. The sheer volume of literature present there was a bit overwhelming, but with time, I started to learn my way around the various binders and books.

Aside from all there was to learn at Herald's Point, there were also classes on all manner of subjects during the War. I managed to make it to a class on tablet weaving, after which I made it a point of getting a small loom for myself. The instructor was rather persuasive to my eager ears. With all of that, the thing I enjoyed most about Lilies was the sheer sense of community among everyone there. When I was Crying, everyone along the route was always asking if our mugs were full, and offering water if they were empty. There were times when people had invited me and others join them for a meal, willingly opening up their camping site and entertaining guests. Then there were the parties - the revelry at the end of a long, hot day, everyone coming together in the spirit of community with their fellow Calontiri. Looking back, I long to be back at Lilies, but then I look forward to next year, and an even more splendid Lilies War.
